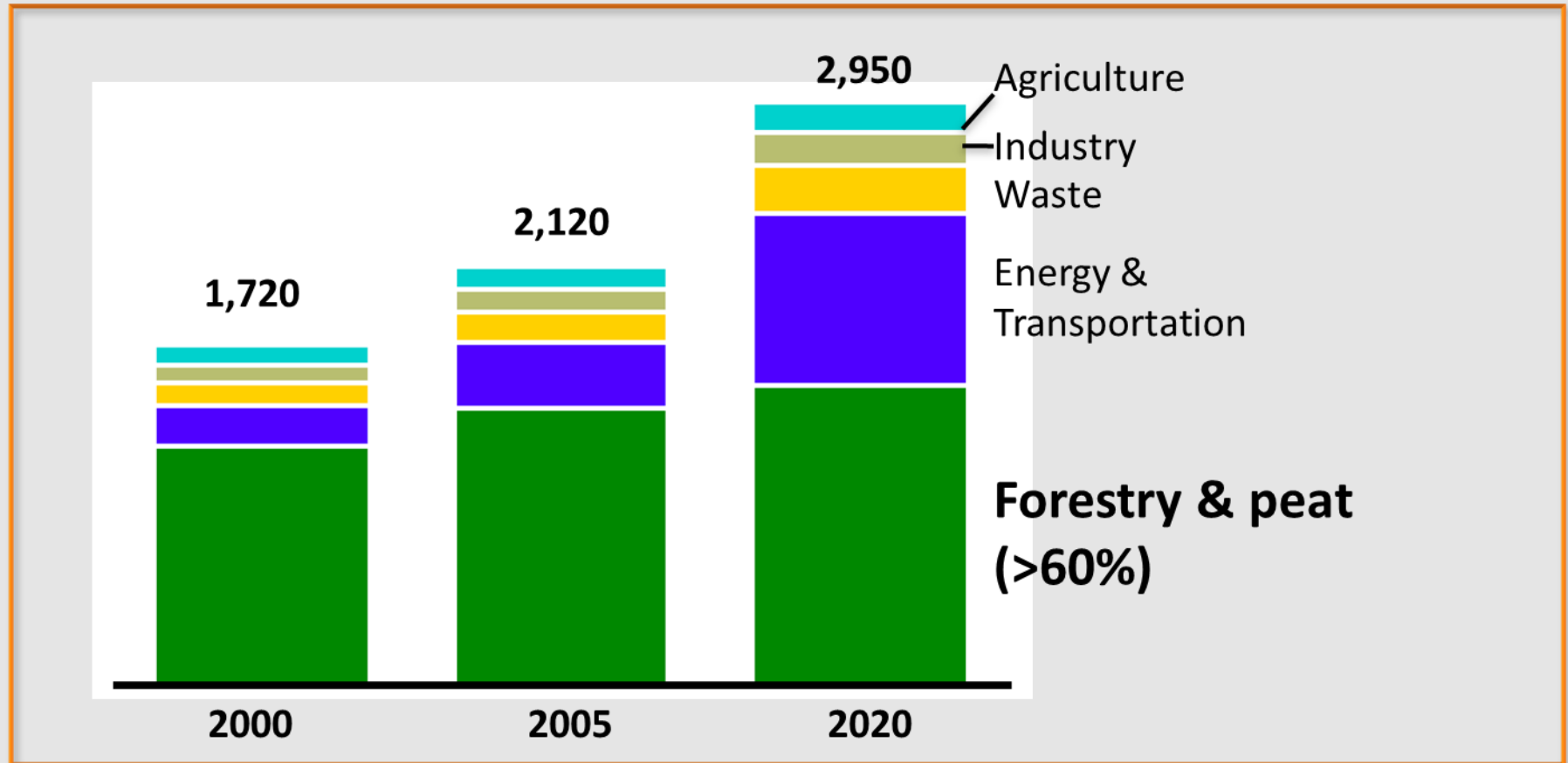

Snapshot of Indonesia's emission profile

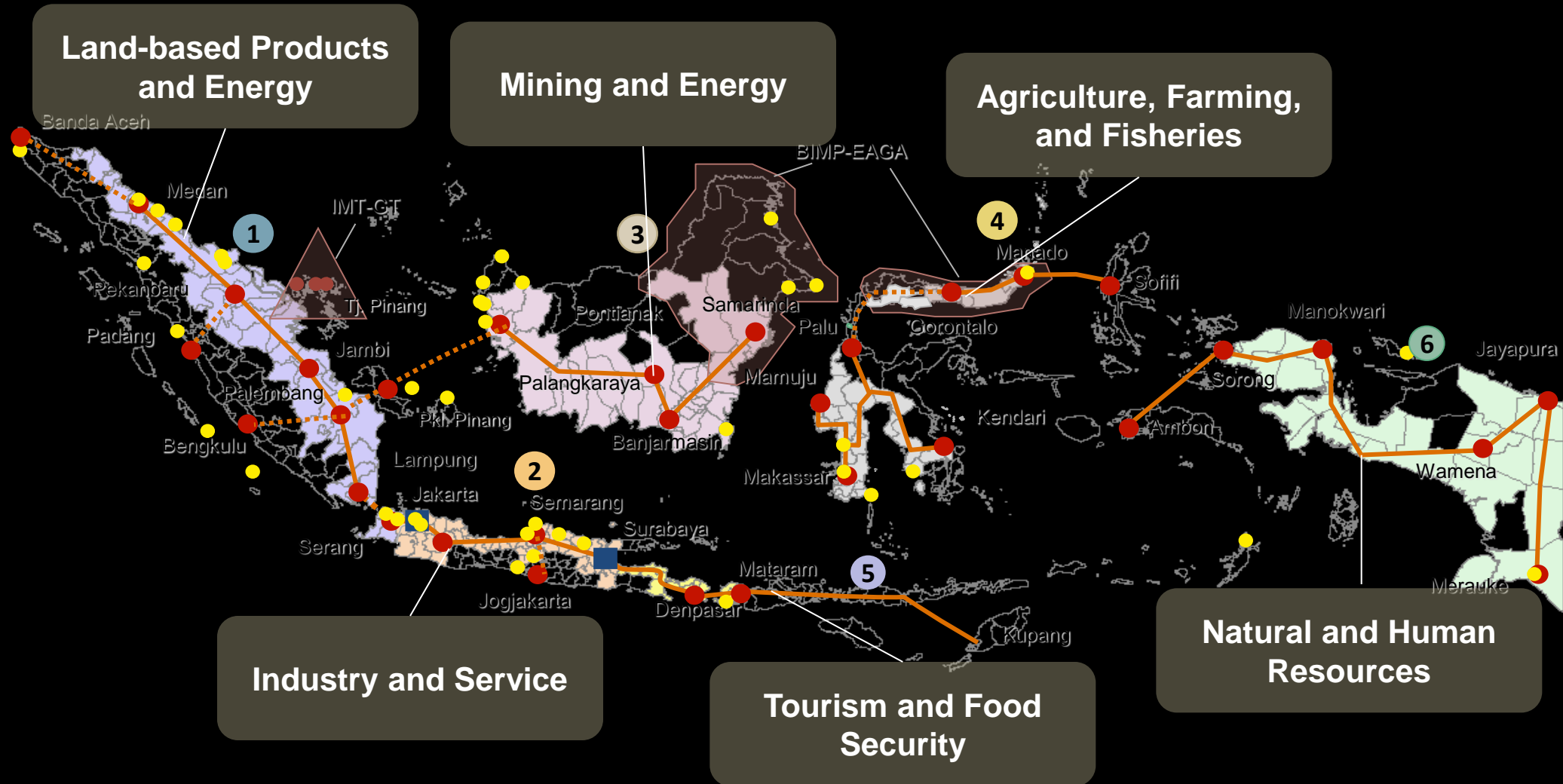
Projected business as usual emissions

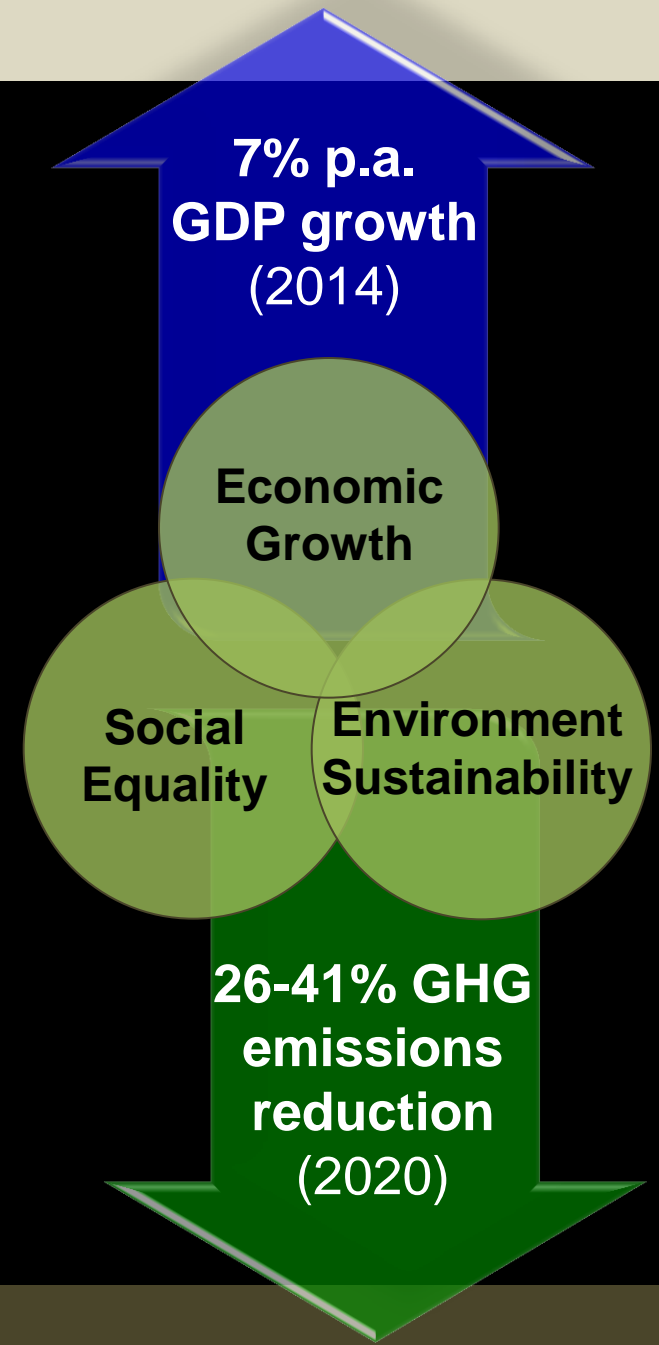

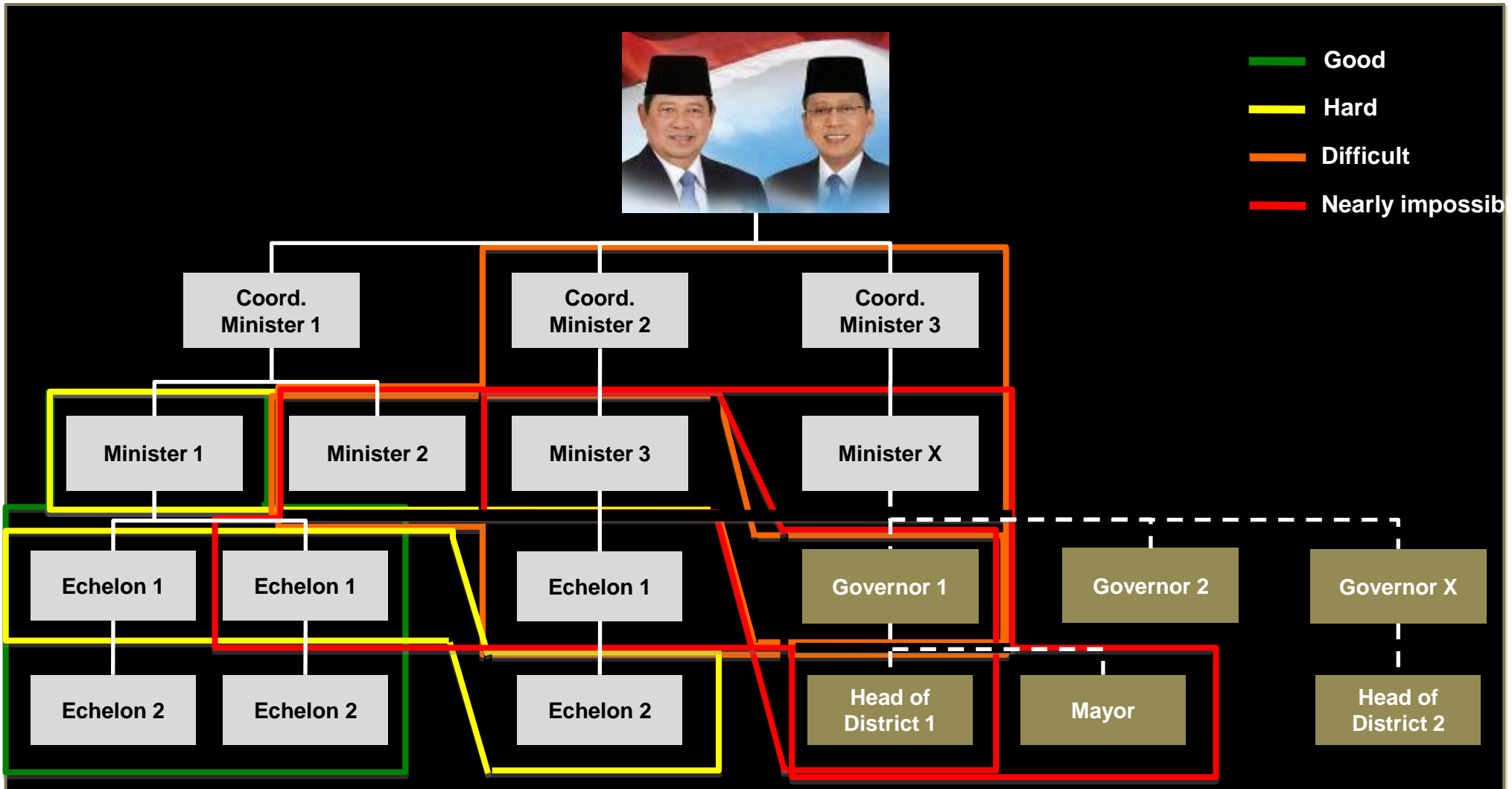

In May 2010, Indonesia signed a **Letter of Intent (LOI)** with Norway to support REDD+ through a contribution of **USD 1 billion** to be paid based on verified emissions

Legal and regulatory framework

Review and revision of regulations and policies

Strategic programs

Strategic activities that lead to the development and the realization of REDD+ programs and projects

4

Paradigm shift

Awareness building and professional as well as technical assistance to communities, organizations, and other entities

5

Stakeholder engagement

Interaction with key groups (e.g., donor management, multi-stakeholder approach, benefit sharing mechanism, safeguard oversight, communications)
