


Snapshot of Indonesia's emission profile


In May 2010, Indonesia signed a Letter of Intent (LOI) with Norway to support REDD+ through a contribution of USD 1 billion to be paid based on verified emissions

Institutions and processes

Setup of institutions and systems that are crucial to the success of REDD+ as well as capability building in existing ministries and agencies



Review and revision of regulations and policies

Strategic programs

Strategic activities that lead to the development and the realization of REDD+ programs and projects

Paradigm shift

Awareness building and professional as well as technical assistance to communities, organizations, and other entities

Stakeholder engagement

Interaction with key groups (e.g., donor management, multi-stakeholder approach, benefit sharing mechanism, safeguard oversight, communications)
