PARTY TO BOTH UNFCCC & KP

- Ratification of UNFCCC in 1994 → Law no. 6/1994
- Ratification of KP in 2004 → Law no. 17/2004
- Has submitted: 2 (two) National Communications (1999 and 2009)
- Has established: Designated National Authority for Clean Development Mechanism in 2005
- Has established: National Council on Climate Change in 2008

INDONESIA'S ROLE

- Host and President of COP13/CMP3 in Bali, 2007
 - Bali Road Map
 - Bali Action Plan
- Pioneering – voluntary commitment to reduce GHG emissions by 26% and up to 41% (26/41)
- Pioneering – REDD+ cooperation
- Middle ground, progressive developing country
 - Cartagena Dialogue

RELEVANT POLICIES

- National Action Plan to Reduce GHG Emissions (RAN-GRK) – Presidential Regulation no. 61/2011
- National Inventory of GHG Emissions – Presidential Regulation no. 71/2011
- Taskforce for REDD+ – Presidential Decree no. 19/2010 renewed by Presidential Decree no. 25/2011
- National Action Plan on Adaptation to Climate Change Impacts (RAN-API) – currently in the process

RELEVANT ACTIVITIES ... (1)

- Studies and assessments:
 - Emission reduction potential
 - Sectoral emission reduction potential and piloting
 - Provincial and local emission reduction potential and piloting
 - Climate vulnerability and resiliences
 - Sectoral as well as locus-based adaptation initiatives and programme
 - Climate financing
 - Technology needs assessment
 - Capacity building assessment

RELEVANT ACTIVITIES ... (2)

- Institutional setting:
 - Establishment of Indonesia Climate Change Trust Fund
 - Establishment of RAN-GRK Secretariat
 - Indonesia Climate Change Center – in the process
 - REDD+ Agency – in the process
 - MRV and Registry Agency – in the process
 - Adaptation National Implementing Entity – in the process

RELEVANT ACTIVITIES ... (3)

- Mitigation actions:
 - CDM projects (81 registered and 5.1million CERs issued)
 - Sectoral activities:
 - Energy related – energy efficiency and renewable as well as clean energy development
 - Transportation related – eco-airports, development of BRT system
 - Forestry related – rehabilitation, sustainable forest management, conservation
 - Agriculture related – less GHG emitting agriculture methods, less GHG paddy variant
 - Waste management – better waste management including 3R and better disposal-sites/methods

RELEVANT ACTIVITIES ... (4)

- Adaptation actions:
 - Development of local adaptation strategies – some regencies
 - Sectoral activities:
 - Infrastructure related – rehabilitation of infrastructures, climate resilient development
 - Forestry related – mangrove plantation
 - Agriculture related – climate-resilient paddy variant
 - Marine related – programme and support to coastal communities especially fisheries related
 - Health related – prevention of climate related disease

POTENTIAL AREAS OF COLLABORATION

- In a more overall and cross-cutting sectors and issues through green development and green economy
- Research and development as well as transfer of technologies:
 - Energy related
 - Water related
 - Forestry related
- Collaboration in the international negotiation fora
